

FLAGS



Green

Start race or practice session.

Standing Yellow

Caution, incident on the track surface. NO PASSING from where you see the flag until you have passed the incident. Can also be used to back up a waving yellow.

Waving Yellow

Caution, incident on or very near the track surface. Be prepared to stop - course could be blocked. NO PASSING from where you see the flag until you have passed the incident.

Yellow & Red Stripes

Surface flat - oil, dirt, and/or water on the racing surface. Be aware - may lose traction.

Blue with Yellow Diagonal Stripe

Passing flag - check your mirrors, someone may want to pass.

Black with Orange Circle

Mechanical black flag - something is wrong with your vehicle. Pull into pits for inspection.

Standing Black

Driver error - come into pits for consultation.

Furled Black

Driver error - warning only. Unnecessary to come into pits, but "don't do it again".

Red

Check mirrors, then come to a safe stop at or near the side of the track. Pull over to one side so the course doesn't get blocked.

Checkered

End of race or practice session. Continue around to pit entrance at reduced speed.
